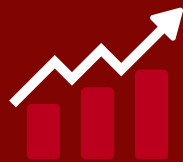

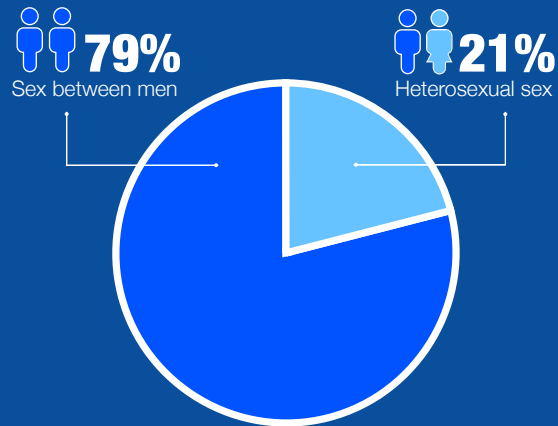

NEW DIAGNOSES
IN 2020

- 38% were previously diagnosed overseas
- 46% of men who have sex with men acquired HIV locally

GET TESTED REGULARLY

More causal partners means more frequent testing.
Get tested at your GP, Sexual Health or by Rapid Testing with a community agency.



EARLY TREATMENT MEANS A LONGER LIFE

Starting treatment as soon as you are diagnosed will help you live a long healthy life and you can't pass on HIV.
